1. India US Financial Cooperation

- US Secretary of State for Finance Wally Adeyemo, who is on a tour of India, met Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in Delhi.

- ❖ In a post published on the Finance Ministry's Twitter page, India will chair the G20 from December 1, 2022 to the end of November 2023.
