State news

1. Parundhu App

❖ An app called 'Parundhu' is soon to be introduced in the **Tamil Nadu Police** to detect and prevent criminal activities and to monitor the activities of the raiders.

2. Sign Language Dictionary

- Sign language is a great support for deaf and dumb people.
- ❖ But lack of clear rules and policies for sign language in India was a major problem.
- ❖ Indian Sign Language Research and Training Center was set up in 2013 to address this.
- ❖ Sign language courses were introduced in many schools when Sign Language Day was celebrated on 23rd September.

3. Medicine in search of people: 90 lakh people benefited

- On August 5, 2021, the Chief Minister launched a program called 'Medicine in search of people' in Samanapalli village of Krishnagiri district.
- Overall 74% of the population has been screened by the medical program.
- Medicine cabinets are provided for people suffering from diseases like diabetes, high blood pressure, supportive care, systemic therapy, dialysis due to kidney damage.
- It is hoped that the number of beneficiaries will cross one crore once the remaining 26 percent public is fully tested.

1. Billionaire Indians

- ❖ The number of millionaires in India is increasing year by year.
- As of 2021, the number of people with assets worth more than Rs 8 crore in India is 7.96 lakh.
- ❖ This number is estimated to **double** in the next four years to **16.23 lakh**.
- Recently IFL published a list of Indians with net worth above 12 crores. There are 113 people in this list.
- More than last year 96 people have joined this list. Real estate, pharmaceuticals, petrochemicals, and software have produced the highest number of billionaires.

- ❖ What does the World Inequality Report 2022 say about rising wealth of Indians?
- **Economically the top 10 percent receive 57 percent of the country's total income.**
- Only 13 percent of the country's total income goes to the economically bottom 50 percent.
- ❖ India is one of the most unequal countries in the world in that respect.

2. 'Ayushman Bharat' Medical Insurance Scheme

- ❖ Ayushman Bharat Medical Insurance Scheme was launched by the Central Government on 23rd September 2018.
- According to this the poor families are provided with insurance up to Rs 5 lakh per annum.
- ❖ All health related details of the public will be stored in a single digital card.
- ❖ A patient who consults a doctor no longer needs to carry paper documents.
- The doctor can easily know all the details related to the health of the patient through the digital card.
- ❖ In the first phase, the scheme was implemented on pilot basis in six Union Territories.
- ❖ Then on 27th September 2021, the National Digital Health Program was officially launched at the national level under the name of 'Ayushman Bharat Digital Movement'.



- ❖ A target of issuing 10 lakh cards per day has been set.
- So far 19 crore people have been given medical insurance cards.
- ❖ The central government is taking various measures to improve the health sector across the country.
- ❖ As part of this, Rs 100 crore will be spent per district under the Ayushman Bharat scheme.
- ❖ Beneficiaries of Ayushman Bharat Health Insurance Scheme are given a **14-digit** identification number.
- ❖ Based on this digital cards are distributed free of cost through Public Service Centers.

3. Storm Noru

- Powerful Cyclone Noru hits North East region. The typhoon hit Purdios City, Quezon Province, Bolillo Island.
- ❖ At that time the wind was blowing at a speed of **195 kilometers** per hour.

4. Defense logistics exports up 334%

- ❖ Defense logistics exports have grown by 334% in the last five years.
- ❖ India currently exports defense logistics to more than 75 countries due to cooperative efforts.
- ❖ India is meeting its demand by manufacturing logistics domestically under 'Make in India' programme.
- ❖ INS Vikrant, the first aircraft carrier made in India, was commissioned into the Navy.
- ❖ Upgraded light 'MIG-3' helicopter to be inducted into Indian Coast Guard.
- ❖ It has been mentioned that the new generation missile carrying nuclear warhead 'Agni-B' was successfully test-fired.

5. Swatch Doikethon

- Central Department of Housing and Urban Development is launching a unique competition to make toys out of waste named Swach Toykethon.
- ❖ The National Action Plan for Toys (NAPD) was launched in 2020 to promote the Indian toy industry, including traditional handicrafts and handmade toys, with the aim of establishing India as a global toy hub.
- ❖ The Prime Minister has announced the vision of 'Garbage Free Cities' by 2026 under the second phase of Clean India.

6. The voice of the mind

The birth anniversary of Bhagat Singh who fought for the freedom of the country is going to be celebrated on 28th September.



- ❖ The important decision has been taken to honor his sacrifice.
- Chandigarh Airport to be named after him.
- ❖ A statue of **Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose** was unveiled a few days ago on Duty Road in Delhi.
