

1. Liz Truss becomes Prime Minister of Britain

Liz Truss, 47, has been elected as the new leader of the Conservative Party.



2. Renaming of Delhi Rajpath as duty line

❖ It has been decided to rename the historic Rajpath in New Delhi as 'Khatavya Patha' (Duty Path), government sources said.

3. Top in murder of seniors in 2021

❖ The National Crime Records Bureau's Suspicious Distinction of Indian Crime 2021 shows that Tamil Nadu has the highest number of elderly homicide victims.

4. India is the fifth largest economy in the world

❖ India has emerged as the world's fifth largest economy, overtaking Britain.

5. 9.25 percent contribution of Tamil Nadu in exports

Tamil Nadu's contribution to India's total exports is 9.25 percent, said Minister of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Department T.M.Anparasan.

6. Sanctuary of the Night Air

Union Minister of State for Science and Technology Jitendra Singh said that India's first night air sanctuary will be set up at Honle in Ladakh within three months, which will boost astrotourism in India.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina said that the aid will be given in the name of 'Vanga bandu' Mujibur Rahman to the injured Indian

11. Approval of nasal anti-coronavirus

Bharat Biotech Company has developed a nasal vaccine called PPV 154 and tested



the drug on about 4000 volunteers in order to solve the problem that the Corona vaccine does not prevent corona infection on the surface of the respiratory tract.

12. Chivingi Tiger Project again

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will launch a plan to reintroduce chives (cheetahs) into Indian forests at Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh on September 17, state Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan said.

13. Vastok

❖ Last September 1st joint military exercise named **VASTOC** started in Russia.

14. List of UNESCO Education Cities

❖ Kerala's Thrissur and Neelumpur cities and Telangana's Warangal city have been included in UNESCO's list of educational cities for their efforts in bringing education to the diverse population.

15. Prime Minister Modi Sheikh Hasina talks and signs 7 agreements

Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina arrived in Delhi yesterday on a four-day visit.

7 contracts

- Later 7 agreements were signed in the presence of the two leaders.
- ➤ They include an agreement for scientific and technological cooperation between premier scientific and industrial research institutions of the two countries.
- Another agreement is related to cooperation in IT applications and IT services in Bangladesh Railways.
- There is also an agreement regarding the release of water from the Kusiara, a common river along the border.
- > This will benefit South Assam and Sylcut region in Bangladesh.
- For Bangladesh Railway Employees,
- Providing training in Indian Railways,
- Training Bangladesh Judicial Officers in India,
- Collaboration between India's Prasar Bharati and Bangladesh Television,
- Includes agreements on cooperation in space technology.

16. PM-Sree Schools

❖ A Rs 27,360 crore scheme to create more than 14,000 'PM-Sree' schools (Prime Minister's Schools for Rising India) across the country to provide quality education to all.



17. Appointment of Central Government Advocate in the Supreme Court

Ramshankar Raja from Rajapalayam has been appointed to appear in the Supreme Court as a lawyer on behalf of the Central Government.

18. As a US District Judge unless of Indian origin Recommendation for appointment

President Joe Biden has recommended the appointment of Indian-origin Arun Subramanian as US District Judge.

19. World Thirukural Conference

- ❖ Hosts 'World Thirukkural Conference-2022' at Angkor Tamil Society, Cambodia.
- ❖ This conference will start on 28th September and will continue till 3rd October next month

20. Death of Queen Elizabeth of Britain

- Britain's long-time queen Elizabeth dies of ill health.
- Elizabeth II, who ascended the throne in 1952 death of her father's accession to the Sixth Charge, has reigned for a record 70 years.
- ❖ He managed 15 British Prime Ministers during his reign.
- ***** The new King Charles:
 - After Elizabeth's death, Crown Prince Charles became the next King of Britain.
 - Prince Charles, the eldest son, immediately became the next king according to the British royal dynasty law.
 - It has been officially announced that he will be known as Charles the Third.
 - Charles is the oldest monarch in British history.

21. A new air-to-air missile test success

❖ Defense Research and Development Organization (TRDO) announced that the ground-launched high-speed surface-to-air missile QURSAM has been successfully test-fired.

22. Appointment of new Indian Ambassador to New Zealand

Senior External Affairs Officer Neethabhushan appointed as the new Indian Ambassador to New Zealand.

23. Approval to increase military joint training

- ❖ Both countries agreed to further strengthen defense cooperation between India and Japan and increase joint military exercises.
- The current year marks the 70th year of diplomatic relations between India and Japan.



❖ Japan's participation in the Indian Navy's **Milan Joint Exercise** and the implementation of the Mutual Supply and Services Agreement were welcomed in the meeting.

24. Duty Path (Khattavya Patha)

❖ The Prime Minister also inaugurated a 28 feet tall statue of freedom struggle leader Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose at the India Gate area.

25. Head of Trafficking and Foreign Exchange Tribunal

Chief Justice Muniswarnath Bhandari of the High Court has been appointed as the Chairman of the Appellate Tribunal in the smuggling and foreign exchange fraud cases.

26. UK national anthem, currency, passport changes

- As Queen Elizabeth II of England passed away and Charles was installed as the new king, the country's national anthem, currency, passport, etc. changed in 1952, Elizabeth II became Queen of England.
- Since then the national anthem of that country has sung the lines 'God Save the Queen'.
- The National Anthem is changed to 'God Save the King' now that Charles is King.

27. Crescent ranks 19th in employability ranking

Crescent Institute of Technology has been ranked 19th in the All India Employability Ranking List.

28. Annual production of 80,000 railway wheels

❖ For the first time, the railway contract point has asked private companies to set up a plant capable of manufacturing at least 80,000 railway wheels per year under the Make in India programme.

29. Strive to eradicate tuberculosis by 2025

- The central government is running a website called 'Nikshai 2.0' to help TB patients.
- Through this TB patients can be adopted and cared for by individuals elected representatives or organizations.

1. Serena Williams retired

- USA's Serena Williams, the crowned queen of women's singles, has won a total of
 23 Grand Slam titles.
- She also has the honor of being the world's Friend One player for the longest time.

2. WTA 250 Competition

- No international women's tennis tournament has ever been held in Chennai.
- ❖ The first WUTA 250 tennis tournament will be held from 12th to 18th at Chennai Nungampakkam STAD tennis ground due to efforts of Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Stalin.
