## **Central News**

#### 1. Nobel Prize for French writer.

- ❖ French author Anne Ernaux has been awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature this year.
- ❖ Author Anne Ernaux initially wrote autobiographical fiction in French.
- ❖ Later he gave up fiction and started publishing the experiences he got through the important events of his life in a natural writing style.
- They became very popular among people.
- So far he has written more than 20 books including 'A Man's Place', 'The Years'.
- He has recorded various emotions including sexual feelings, abortions, illness and death of parents.
- ❖ In his books he also recorded social and family matters.
- It is noteworthy that she was the first French woman writer to win the Nobel Prize for Literature.

# 2. Four Controversial Cough Medicines of India

- ❖ The World Health Organization had reported that 66 children died in the West African country of Gambia, which may have been caused by the side effect of taking cough medicines made in India.
- ❖ Promethazine, Caffexmelin, Make Off, Magrif N cough and cold medicines manufactured by Maiden Pharma Pharmaceuticals Ltd., Haryana were found to contain high levels of diethylene glycol and ethylene glycol.
- ❖ They can cause **kidney failure**. Based on this, the World Health Organization has issued this warning.

# 3. Memorandum of Understanding

- ❖ A memorandum of understanding is soon to be signed between the Medical University of Malta and Dr. MGR Medical University of Tamil Nadu regarding the sharing of medical research technology and job opportunities.
- ❖ There are various job opportunities in the medical sector in Malta. Medical travel between the two countries will also increase.

## 4. British Royal College Medical Conference begins

- British Royal College of Surgeons Edinburgh International Conference of Medical Specialists and Surgeons started in Chennai.
- ❖ More than thousand experts from more than 60 countries participated in it.
- ❖ This is the first time that the conference of the Royal College of Surgeons, considered to be the oldest and foremost of the surgical colleges in the world, is being held outside Britain and especially in Chennai, which is almost 500 years old.



- ❖ The Royal College is providing quality research and technology based medical education for future generations.
- ❖ The institute is running with seven departments like Robotics, Dental Surgery, Advanced Surgery.

## 5. ISRO launches 36 satellites

- ❖ The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) plans to launch 36 British satellites by the end of this month on a GSLV M-3 heavy rocket.
- ❖ The project to be implemented for commercial use is being carried out on the basis of MoUs between ISRO's 'New Space India' and UK's 'One Web'.
- ❖ To be launched 36 satellites are scheduled to be launched from the Satish Dhawan II launch pad in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh in the third or fourth week of this month.
