State news

1. Ban on internet gambling

- Governor RN Ravi has approved the emergency law to ban internet gambling in Tamil Nadu.
- This Act has been published in the Tamil Nadu Gazette on October 3rd and has come into force since then.
- ❖ Internet gambling has been banned in Tamil Nadu.
- Online gambling with monetary items is prohibited.
- Similarly it is prohibited to provide any internet gambling for public use.
- ❖ If you play internet gambling
 - > Three months imprisonment Rs 5000 fine for players,
 - > Imprisonment for one year and fine up to Rs.5 lakhs for the advertiser,
 - ➤ Three years imprisonment and fine up to Rs 10 lakhs for those who provide games.

Central News

1. Primary agricultural credit in all panchayats by 2027 Associations

- Primary Agricultural Credit Societies will be set up in all panchayats in the country by 2027.
- Union Home and Cooperatives Minister Amit Shah said that the co-operative activities including marketing of dairy products will be given impetus at the basic level.
- ❖ He mentioned that it is very important to have these societies in all panchayats within the next five years as 65 thousand primary agricultural credit societies are currently functioning across the country.
- ❖ The Minister inaugurated the Conference of Milk Producers and Co-operative Societies of Eastern and North Eastern Regions in Gangtok, the capital of Sikkim.

Doubling of milk production is necessary:

➤ The Minister also said that it is necessary to double the production of milk in the country in the next five years.

2. Divide the Nobel Peace Prize into three

Ales Bieliatsky

- Prominent leader who has been fighting for democratic rights in Belarus since the 1980s, a period of authoritarian rule.
- ❖ He has been insisting that importance should be given to human rights in the country.
- ❖ Belarus arrested him in 2020 as anti-government protests escalated.



❖ Till date he has been imprisoned without any trial. Ales Peliatsi has been awarded the Nobel Prize.

Russia's 'Memorial System'

- ❖ Founded in **1987** in the Soviet Union, the center fought against communist oppression.
- ❖ The Center continues to collect information on the human rights of the Russian government.
- Continues to investigate the status of political prisoners in Russia.
- ❖ The Center continues to push for an end to repression and emphasis on human rights in Russia.
- ❖ The Center is also saying that rule based on law should be implemented.

Center for Human Freedom of Ukraine:

- The center was launched in 2007 with an emphasis on human rights and democracy when Ukraine was going through a crisis.
- The Center took steps to make it a democratic country.
- This center also ensured that the country was ruled by law.
- ❖ The Center has continued to document Russia's war violations since the start of the war.
- ❖ The Center is working to bring due **punishment to the Russian** officials involved in the violation.

Sports news

1. Qatar World Cup is the last match

- Argentinian football star Lionel Messi has said that the World Cup to be held in Qatar in November will be his last.
- ❖ The Qatar match will be **Messi's fifth World Cup match**.
- ❖ Argentina has so far won the World Cup twice in 1978 and 1986.
- ❖ The 22nd FIFA World Cup will start on November 20 and end on December 18.
