- World Postal Day.
- ❖ The Universal Postal System was started in 1874 in Bern, Switzerland.
- ❖ World Postal Day was declared on **9th October 1969** to commemorate the Universal Postal System.
- This day is celebrated to appreciate the services of this Durai and to make people aware about its schemes.

- ❖ A number of projects have been launched due to the modernization of school education sector with the introduction of digital technology.
- Also a **new application (app)** is going to be launched to help students understand and study the subject.
- ❖ Digitized statistics guide the Chief Minister's breakfast programme.
- The scheme of providing glasses is also implemented through digitized statistics.

#### **Central News**

### 1. Child Marriage Jharkhand tops

- ❖ The Office of the Registrar General and Census Commissioner of the Union Ministry of Home Affairs conducted a study on child marriages.
- ❖ Jharkhand has the highest number of child marriages in the country.
- ❖ The percentage of women who marry as children has increased to **5.8** in this state.
- ❖ Nationally the percentage of women in child marriage is 1.9%.
- Child marriage in Jharkhand is 7.3 percent in rural areas and three percent in urban areas.
- ❖ Jharkhand and West Bengal are the only two states where more than half of the girls are married before the age of 21.
- ❖ In West Bengal 54.9% girls get married before reaching 21 years of age.
- ❖ In Jharkhand this figure is **54.6 percent**. The national average is **29.5 percent**.

# 2. Air Force New Weapons Division

- ❖ Indian Air Force Chief of Staff VR Chaudhary said that the Central Government has approved the establishment of a separate weapon system unit for Indian Air Force officers.
- He also informed that women will also be selected for the Air Force from next year



under the 'Agnipath' scheme.

❖ The 90th Foundation Day of the Indian Air Force was celebrated at the Air Force Base in Chandigarh.

# **Special Weapons Section:**

- ➤ The Central Government has approved the creation of a separate Armament Unit for Air Force officers.
- > This is the first time that this unit has been set up since independence.
- Missiles that attack targets on the ground and in the state from the ground, aircraft that can be controlled from a distance through 'remote', weapons carried in the aircraft will be included in the weapon system category.
- ➤ Through this the officers can be easily trained. So Rs 3400 crores will be saved.
