# 1. Tamiliyaka Award

- ❖ Tamil scholar P. Aruli has been selected to receive the award of Tamiliyakkam.

  Tamil scholar Aruli was born and lives in Puducherry.
- He studied Commerce and Law.
- ❖ He was deeply involved in the principles of **Bavanar and Perunchitranar.**
- Proficient in Tamil etymological studies.
- ❖ He is a famous orator in Tamil Nadu and abroad due to his pure Tamil speech.
- Founder of Tamilnath charity and social philanthropist.
- Served as Head of the Department of Pure Tamil-Orthodox Akara, Tanjore Tamil University.
- ❖ He authored about 30 books and more than 250 articles.
- Presented theses in universities.

#### **Central News**

## 1. Cable bridge over river Krishna

- ❖ For the first time in the country, a cable (wire) bridge is going to be constructed over the Krishna River to connect the two Telugu states of Andhra Telangana at a cost of Rs 1082.56 crore.
- Central Government has given approval for this.
- The cable-stayed flyover will start at Someseela in Nagar Kurnool District, Telangana and will end at Atmakur, Kurnool District in Andhra Pradesh.
- Minister Gadkari said that if the construction of this bridge is completed, it will be the second cable bridge in the world and the first cable bridge in the country.

#### 2. GSLV M-3

- ❖ The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) plans to launch 36 British satellites on the 23rd on the GSLV M-3 heavy rocket.
- The project, which is to be implemented for commercial use, is being carried out on the basis of separation agreements between ISRO's 'New Space India' and Britain's 'One Web'.



- ❖ It is 43.5 meters tall and weighs 640 tons.
- One of the world's leading telecommunication companies, OneWeb, will deploy these satellites for telecommunication services for government, commercial and educational applications.
- ❖ India's Bharti Telecom is a major shareholder and investor in OneWeb.

#### 3. INS Arihant

- India's nuclear powered submarine INS Arihant has successfully launched a ballistic missile from under the sea.
- ❖ These tests were carried out in the Bay of Bengal and the air-launched missile accurately hit the target.

## 4. Jio tops in 5G speed

- Reliance Jio tops India's fifth-generation communication technology 5G download speed, according to internet speed testing firm Oogla.
- ❖ Tested the speed of 5G internet connectivity in the country through 'Speed Test Intelligence' technology.
- ❖ Airtel's 5G download speed was up to 197.98 Mbps in this test conducted in Delhi.
- ❖ Meanwhile the download speed of Jio 5G connection was up to **598.58 Mbps**.
- ❖ Bharti Airtel has launched its 5G service in Chennai, Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Siliguri, Nagpur and Varanasi.
- ❖ Jio is also providing its 5G service in trial mode in **Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and Varanasi.**
