1. Four storms

- ❖ A powerful typhoon called 'Nalke' hit the southern parts of the **Philippines.**

2. Ban on new petrol-diesel cars from 2035: Europe decision

- ❖ The European Union has decided to ban the sale of new internal combustion engine cars running on petrol and diesel from 2035 onwards.
- In this regard, the member states have entered into an agreement titled 'Plan for 55 goals'.
- ❖ The European Union has set a target of reducing the emissions of greenhouse gases responsible for global warming and climate change by 55 percent by 2030.
- ❖ The internal engine car ban agreement is a part of the measures to achieve that goal.
- ❖ Under the agreement, member states must commit automakers to reduce emissions of greenhouse gases by 55 percent by 2030 and completely after five years.

3. World's tallest Shiva statue in Rajasthan

- ❖ The 369-feet tall Lord Shiva statue erected in Rajasthan's Rajsamand district is set to open for darshan of devotees.
- ❖ The statue, installed by the **Dut Padam Sansthan**, is said to be the tallest Shiva statue in the world.
- ❖ In the presence of Chief Minister Ashok Khelat, Assembly President C.P. Joshi and others, this gigantic Shiva idol is going to be opened for the darshan of the devotees.
- ❖ A meditative idol of Lord Shiva has been installed on a hill in Nathwara town of Rajsamand district.
- The tallest Shiva statue in the world has elevators, stairs and a hall for devotees.
- ❖ 3,000 tonnes of iron and steel and 2.5 lakh cubic tonnes of concrete have been used for the construction. The construction work has been going on for about ten years.
- ❖ Built to last **250 years**. It can also withstand winds of up to **250 kilometers** per hour.

4. Central government permission to increase moisture level of paddy to 19 percent

Moisture content of paddy procured in Delta districts is allowed to increase from 17 percent to 19 percent.



The minimum support price for normal paddy has been fixed at Rs 2040 per quintal and for fine paddy at Rs 2060 per quintal.

5. INS Vikrant

- ❖ INS Vikrant, the country's first aircraft carrier, was completely indigenously built.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that he is witnessing the strength of the Indian steel manufacturing sector.
- Prime Minister Modi participated via video at the foundation laying ceremony for expansion works of ArcelorMittal Tippan Steel Company in Gujarat's Surat district.

6. Twitter owner Elon Musk

- **❖** Tesla owner Elon Musk has finalized the deal to buy the internationally renowned social networking company Twitter for around ₹3,52,000 crore.
- On his first day as a Twitter owner, Elon Musk fired four senior executives, including chief executive officer (CEO) Barak Agarwal, the company's legal officer and Indian Vijaya Khate.

7. One country-one police uniform

- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi proposed the idea of 'One Nation-One Police Uniform' to introduce uniform uniform for all policemen across the country.
- ❖ A brainstorming session involving State Home Ministers began in **Surajkund**, **Haryana**.
- There should be co-operation between states in preventing crimes and identifying criminals.
