Important Days

1. 03-11-22

- ❖ The **birth anniversary** of Sawai Jai Singh, Annapurna Maharana, Amartya Sen, and Manavjit Singh Sandhu.
- Annapurna Maharana-
 - ✓ She was also a prominent social and women's rights activist.
- Sawai Jai Singh-
 - ✓ a brave and very diplomatic king . He is also known as 'Jaisingh II'
- Amartya Sen-
 - ✓ The first Asian to receive the 1998 Nobel Prize for Economics.
- Manavjit Singh Sandhu-
 - ✓ In 2006, he won a gold medal in trapshooting at the World Championships in Zagreb.
- ❖ 3 November is also observed as the **death anniversary** of Major Somnath Sharma, and Chidambaram Pillai.
- Major Somnath Sharma-
 - ✓ a company-commander of the Delta Company of the 4th Battalion of the Kumaon Regiment of the Indian Army, which served in the Indo-Pak war of October–November 1947.
- Chidambaram Pillai-
 - ✓ Chidambaram Pillai propagated Swadeshi in the movement against 'Bang-Bhang'.

Central News

1. Fertilizer subsidy Rs. 51,875 crore approved by the Union Cabinet

- ❖ The Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved a subsidy of Rs 51,875 crore for phosphate and potassium fertilizers.
- ❖ During the Rabi season 2022-23 from October 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023, phosphate potassium fertilizers have been approved to provide nutrients like nitrogen, phosphorus, potash, sulfur at subsidized rates.
- ❖ Accordingly, subsidy will be provided for nitrogen at Rs.98.02, phosphorus at Rs.66.93, potash at Rs.23.65 and sulfur at Rs.6.12 per kg.
- ❖ With this, the Cabinet has approved a total subsidy of Rs.51,875 crore.
- Ethanol Price Increase:
 - ✓ The price of sugarcane ethanol, which is blended with petrol, has been increased from Rs.63.45 (lit) to Rs. The Cabinet also approved the amendment as 65.61



- ✓ Similarly, the price of **C-heavy molasses** extracted ethanol has increased from Rs.46.66 (lit) to Rs. 49.41 and it was decided to increase the price of B-heavy ethanol from Rs.59.08 to Rs.60.73.
- ✓ Currently, **10 percent ethanol** is blended into gasoline. As a result, the farmers have got Rs.40 thousand crores which were to go abroad.
- ✓ It has been decided to increase ethanol consumption to **12 percent** from next year.

❖ Airport renaming:

✓ The cabinet approved the renaming of the green airport at Halonghi, Thalainagar, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh to Donyi Polo Airport, Itanagar.

State news

1. Rajaraja Cholan's birthday is a government event

- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M. K. Stalin has announced that the birthday of Rajaraja Chola will be celebrated as a state festival.
- Rajaraja Chola's birthday is celebrated annually as a Sadaya festival by various organizations in Thanjavur district. There have been requests from various quarters to declare the birthday as a government holiday.
- Accepting this request, Rajaraja Cholan's birthday will be celebrated as a state festival this year and in the years to come.

Sathaya Festival:

- ✓ The birthday of Rajaraja Chola, who built the world-famous Thanjavur Great Temple, is celebrated as the Sadaya Festival every year in the month of Aippasi in the Sataya Nakshatra.
- This year Rajaraja Chola's 1037th Sadaya Festival began on Wednesday at Thanjavur Periya Kovil.

Missile

1. Target interception missile AT-1 test success

- The AT-1 interceptor missile was successfully test-fired on Wednesday for the first time.
- ❖ The AT-1 interceptor has a range of 100 km of the atmosphere. It is designed to flow in two ways, above and below the height.
- ❖ It can intercept and attack long-range ballistic missiles and aircraft. The missile has an indigenously developed modern control system and guidance.



The missile was successfully test-fired for the first time at different locations off the coast of ABJ Abdul Kalam Island in Odisha.

Economic news

1. Wheat exports doubled to Rs.12,200 crores

- ❖ Wheat exports worth USD 1.48 billion (roughly Rs 12,200 crore in Indian value) during the six months from April to September of the current financial year, the Union Commerce Ministry said on Wednesday.
- This is reported to be more than double compared to the same period of the previous financial year.
- ❖ Wheat exports worth USD 630 million (Rs 5,200 crore) during the same period of the previous financial year.
- ❖ The overall export value of agricultural and processed food products has increased by 25 percent in the last six months.
- Exports have now increased to USD 13.77 billion (about Rs 1 lakh crore) from USD 11.05 billion (Rs 91,000 crore) in the corresponding period of the previous fiscal.

Appointment

1. CRPF women officers appointed as I.G for the first time

- For the first time, a woman officer has been appointed as the IG of the Central Reserve Police Force's (CRPF) anti-riot special force Rapid Response Force (RAAF).
- Similarly, for the first time, the Bihar division of the CRPF has a woman IG. Appointed.
- ❖ The country's largest paramilitary force, the CRPF (3.25 lakh personnel), was inducted for the first time in 1987 after years of waiting.
- ❖ In this case, female officer Annie Abraham has been appointed as IG of CRPF Rapid Action Force and Seema Dundia as IG of Bihar Division, according to the order issued by the head office of the force.
- ❖ Woman IG for Rapid Response Force This is the first time to lead.
- ❖ Both of them will miss the category of women officers who joined the CRPF service for the first time in 1987.
- ❖ It is noteworthy that she has already headed the Indian Women's Police Committee at the UN and will also receive the President's Police Medal for her outstanding work.

World news

1.To get 'Blue Tick' on Twitter Rs. 662 fee

- New owner Elon Musk has announced that Twitter users will have to pay \$8 a month (Rs. 662) to get a blue tick, which indicates an authenticated account.
- ❖ The company launched the 'Blue Tick' service in **2009** after Twitter came under court criticism for not taking steps to prevent fake accounts.

2.Israel: Netanyahu becomes Prime Minister again

- ❖ Israel's Prime Minister **Netanyahu** is expected to be re-elected in general election, with polls showing a majority for the ruling Likud party.
- ❖ Netanyahu already holds the record of being the longest serving Prime Minister in Israel. After a brief hiatus, the prime minister is almost certain to return.
