## **Important Days**

#### 1. 14-11-22

## ❖ National Children's Day

- ✓ Jawahar Lal Nehru was born on November 14, 1889 to Motilal Nehru and Suvaruparani in Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh. Born in a wealthy family, his father worked as a lawyer.
- ✓ The word 'Negar' referring to the Kashmir Canal was changed to 'Nehru' referring to the lineage of Maruvi Jawaharlal Nehru.
- ✓ In 1916, Nehru accompanied his father to the Congress meeting in Lucknow where he met Gandhiji.
- ✓ However, it was the Jallianwala Bagh massacre in 1919 that motivated Nehru to fully join the Congress and fight for the country.
- ✓ In 1920, he participated in the **non-cooperation movement** of Gandhijis and went to jail for the first time. Jawaharlal Nehru soon became one of Gandhi's confidents.
- ✓ Nehru spent 9 years of his life in prison, during his prison days he wrote books including 'Views of World History', 'Autobiography', 'Discovery of India'.
- ✓ Nehru presided over the program of the Indian National Congress held in Lahore in 1929. He declared that he wanted complete independence from the grip of the British government.
- ✓ On 15th August 1947 when India became independent, Nehru was given the distinction of hoisting the flag of independent India in Delhi.
- ✓ He was the Prime Minister of India from 15th August 1947 till his death on 27th May 1964. His ashes were scattered all over the Indian nation from Kanyakumari to Kashmir.
- ✓ The birthday of **Jawaharlal Nehru**, who loved children, is celebrated as Children's Day in India.

#### **Appointment**

#### 1. KP George re-elected as US judge

- ❖ Indian-origin K.P.George has been re-elected is a judge at Fort Bend, Texas, USA.
- ❖ A native of Kerala, K.P. George (57). He immigrated to the United States and ran for the Democratic Party in the judge election for the Fort Bend area in that country.
- With around 2.46 lakh votes cast in this election, George defeated his opponent Trevor Nels of the Republican party by almost 8,000 votes. He got 52 percent of the votes.
- ❖ With this, George, who was already serving as Fort Bend Texas Justice has been reelected as that area judge.

## **Conference**

#### 1. G-20 Summit:

- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi is on a three-day official visit to Indonesia to attend the G-20 Summit.
- ❖ This conference, which is considered as a confluence of major economic countries, is being held on November 15 and 16 in Bali, Indonesia.



- ❖ In this, Prime Minister Modi and the leaders of the Member States will mainly discuss the global economy, energy, environment, digital transformation, Ukraine issue and its implications.
- ❖ Indian External Affairs Secretary Vinay Quadra said that Prime Minister Modi will participate in three important sessions related to food and energy security, digital transformation and health.
- ❖ While Indonesia currently holds the G-20 presidency, India will formally take over on December 1. Thus, this conference is important for India.
- ❖ In G-20, a group of important developed and developing countries in the world, Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, South Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, Britain, The United States and the European Union are also present.
- ❖ These confederation countries contribute 85 percent of the world's total production and 75 percent of international trade.
- These countries have two-thirds of the world's population.
