1. Goa International Film Festival

- ❖ **Spanish film director Carlos Saura** is being honored with the **Satyajitre Lifetime Achievement Award** at the **53rd International Film Festival** of India starting November 20 in Goa.
- ❖ Also, Union Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting L. Murugan said that three films of veteran actress Asha Parekh, who recently won the Dadasaheb Phalke award, will be screened and honored at the International Film Festival of India.
- ❖ A '**Book Adaptation Project**' is introduced at the film festival. It has been introduced as an attempt to bridge the gap between good stories published as novels and movies adapted from them under the name of 'Books to Box Office', as was the case at the Venice Film Festival.
